Workshop abstracts should be submitted to Linda Lissemore (llissemo@uoguelph.ca) by April 17 2014, as a word document. For those who would like to bring a poster to the workshop, please send the title and size of the poster to be displayed.

For submitted abstracts: Underline the name of the presenting author. Leave a double space before starting the text and a single space between paragraphs. The text should be no longer than 300 words and include the purpose, findings, conclusions and areas that may require future work. New Times Roman font should be used (minimum 11 pt). Any references should be sequentially numbered (in superscript form) in the text by the order of mention. The complete citation must be placed at the end of the text.
