Announcement and Call for Abstracts

May 14 – 15, 2018

The 53rd Canadian Trace Organic Workshop will be held in Vancouver, BC, on May 14 and 15 at the Pacific Gateway Airport Hotel.

The Meeting

The Workshop, formerly known as the Western Canadian Trace Organic Workshop (WCTOW), has become a national meeting with the inclusion of an Eastern venue every fourth year. The workshop continues to focus on state-of-the-art instrumental analysis and sample preparation techniques for a broad range of organic constituents in various matrices. This workshop is an opportunity to discuss and present research relating to trace organic analysis. Attendees are invited to make 20 minute oral presentations. Poster presentations are also welcome.

The scope of topics includes analytical results and procedures for trace organic analysis of residues in food, air, water, vegetation, soils and biological matrices. Presentations on partially completed studies, method development, reports on problem areas and new analytical approaches (instrumental and sample preparation techniques) are also welcome.

There will be a **pre-registration mixer on the evening of Sunday, May 13** at the hotel.

On Monday evening (May 14), there will be a social event at a yet to be determined location, which will include a dinner.
