

# 54<sup>th</sup> Annual Canadian Trace Organic Workshop

The 54<sup>th</sup> Annual Canadian Trace Organic Workshop (CTOW) will be held in Edmonton, Alberta, on May 13-14, 2019 at the Fantasyland Hotel, West Edmonton Mall. The meeting is shaping up to be a fun and informative event!

A mixer and pre-registration will be held on the evening of May 12, 2019 on the Santa Maria in West Edmonton Mall. The Santa Maria is an exact replica of Christopher Columbus' flagship used to sail to the Americas in 1492.

On Monday evening (May 13), there will be a social event at Telus World of Science, which will include a dinner, the presentation of the Caledon and Vogon awards and a show in the IMAX theatre.

This long-standing workshop provides an opportunity to network and exchange ideas regrading trace organic analytical methods and research (wide range of testing, sample types and projects) with your colleagues. We have two keynote speakers to start off the presentations each day – Nicole Heshka of Natural Resources Canada and Jean Birks of InnoTech Alberta will share details and stories of their research projects.
