54th Annual Canadian Trace Organic Workshop

Edmonton is proud to host the 54th Annual Canadian Trace Organic Workshop (CTOW). The workshop will be held May 13-14, 2019, with a mixer and pre-registration on the evening of May 12, 2019. A social evening is being planned for Monday, May 13, 2019.

This long-standing workshop provides an opportunity to network and exchange ideas regarding trace organic analytical methods and research with your colleagues. Presentations may describe analytical methods and development; research results (completed or work in progress); discuss problems; share information concerning testing activities; and provide updates of new testing technologies in relation to trace organic analysis of different sample types (e.g. food, feeds, air, plants, animal products, water).

The Organizing Committee invites participants to make oral presentations of 20 to 30 minutes in duration. Please note that since this is an informal scientific meeting, presentations do not need to be highly polished. There will also be space (first come first served) for poster presentations.

Registration costs for the workshop is \$200.00 (\$50.00 for students). Fees for student registration may be waived with a PowerPoint presentation or reduced with a poster presentation upon approval by the organizing committee.
